### **DWR Announces First Step in New Delta Knowledge Funding Program and Schedules Public Meeting**

SACRAMENTO - The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has released the Delta Knowledge Improvement Funding Program Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP).

DWR will provide funding to non-profit agencies, public agencies, private consultants, and academic institutions for studies/investigations to improve knowledge of Delta levee material properties and/or conditions in a variety of other areas, such as ecosystem, delta assets, and water quality.

As much as \$2,000,000 is available for this program with a maximum of \$250,000 for any one proposal.
