### **DWR Releases Draft Integrated Regional Water Management Grant Program Guidelines and Proposal Solicitation Packages**

SACRAMENTO - The Department of Water Resources (DWR) announces release of the Draft IRWM Grant Program Guidelines, Planning Grant PSP, Implementation Grant PSP, and Stormwater Flood Management Grant PSP.

The Guidelines and PSPs will be used in distribution of grant funding pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) and the Disaster Preparedness and Flood Prevention Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 1E).
