## **2014 Urban Streams Restoration Program's Guidelines and Proposal Solicitation Package**

The California Department of Water Resources issued the final 2014 Urban Streams Restoration Program's Guidelines and Proposal Solicitation Package. DWR is soliciting proposals for \$7.9 million in Proposition 13 & 84 funds for projects that protect, restore and enhance urban creek channels through effective and efficient flood damage reduction approaches that will preserve, restore, and enhance natural environmental values to local communities.
