## Agencies Hold Two-Day Tribal Government Consultation on Proposition 1 Water Bond

**SACRAMENTO** — The Proposition 1 water bond is legislation for all California citizens, including Native American Tribal Governments that are eligible grantees for funding under this initiative. This week, several state agencies will host a forum to share information about the \$7.45 billion general obligation bond approved by voters last November and designed to improve the state's water supply, quality and infrastructure.

- WHO:** Department of Water Resources (DWR), State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), California Water Commission (CWC), California Department of Fish and Wildlife (DFW).
- WHAT:** Prop 1 funding/grant information and what is available to Tribes

- WHY:** The meetings are designed to provide information and answer questions from the California Tribal Community. Representatives from DWR, SWRCB, CWC and DFW will be on hand to describe Proposition 1 Water funding opportunities. The bond authorized funding for water projects including surface and groundwater storage, ecosystem and watershed protections and restoration, and drinking water protection. Within our represented agencies -- DWR, SWRCB, CWC and DFW -- seven programs administer Proposition 1 funding.
