Subject : 2005 Annual Diving Re-certification from Scripps Institution of Oceanography

Once again, the Department of Water Resources Underwater Investigation Team will be completing their annual re-certification training course through the Scripps Institution of Oceanography (SIO), September 25th- 30th, 2005. As in previous years, the course will include the required CPR & first aid refresher, oxygen demand training, safety reviews, written and physical skills checkouts, and supervised diving under various conditions. This training satisfies the requirements established under the Project O&M Instruction No. ST-9, Diving Policy.

Bi-Annual diving physical examinations, equipment inspections and training approvals must be completed prior to the course start. All necessary SCUBA diving equipment should be brought to Scripps with the exception of air tanks, which will be provided.

Lectures, including CPR, First Aid and O2 training, will be held at Scripps Institution of Oceanography. Scripps staff and Christian McDonald, SIO Diving Safety Officer, will provide all necessary instruction and training for the week. A specific meeting room has not been set, so we will gather at Christian McDonald's office on Monday, September 26th, 2005, 8:00 A.M. DWR State vehicles will provide local diving transportation.

When completing your TREV, please keep in mind the following factors:

Each individual or Division team should arrange transportation to San Diego.

Lodging and per diem expenses will be the responsibility of each diver.

Lodging may exceed the delegated lodging rates. Submit an excess lodging rate request/approval Std.255C.

Cost of the dive boat charter will be divided equally amongst the DWR divers and their respective work authorities. The charter fee is estimated at \$7600 or about \$690 per DWR diver, assuming eleven DWR divers. Charter fees include day and night diving, two nights on board, meals for Tuesday & Wednesday, weights, tanks, and air are included in the fee.

Scripps Institution of Oceanography will provide First Aid, CPR and O2 recertification at \$50 per diver, payment will be made to Jordan's First aid.
