

## **WOMT Meeting Notes Meeting of May 29, 2007**

The Water Operations Management Team (WOMT) met on Tuesday May 29, 2007 to discuss operations and fish status. WOMT discussions followed up on discussions at the May 22 and May 25 meetings focused on actions to protect delta smelt.

The discussion focused on trying to maintain OMR flows greater than or equal to zero. WOMT decided that pumping would be continued at the minimal levels, with only enough export to provide necessary SWP supplies to the South Bay Aqueduct urban customers, and for the CVP to operate one pump unit only at Jones to maintain supplies to the City of Tracy and agricultural users upstream of the O'Neill pumps.

The WOMT decided to allow closure of the Delta Cross Channel gates for several days for water quality protection, and to re-open the gates for the coming weekend. The WOMT also agreed to continue the Stanislaus River flow at 1,500 cfs pending identification of additional sources of water to maintain San Joaquin River inflow to the Delta. A follow-up WOMT call was set for Thursday May 31 to assess any new information.
