

WOMT Summary for 7/8/2008:

Citing the level of concern is low based on the Smelt Working Group's review of current Delta water temperatures, low salvage numbers at export facilities, and latest smelt surveys showing the distribution down to Chipps Island. WOMT has decided to allow Projects to export under normal operations to meet Delta outflow standards. Also, all three temporary agricultural barriers in the South Delta can be operated normally (without tied-open barriers' flapgates) to minimize water level and water quality impacts upstream of the barriers. The Smelt Working Group will continue to monitor the situation and convene if conditions warrant.
