

WOMT Summary for June 16, 2009:

As anticipated, and despite operating to minimal export levels, the Project operators reported that meeting the past week's OMR flow objective proved problematic due to hydrologic conditions beyond the Projects' control.

For the coming week, the Projects will implement the USFWS' determination that OMR flows shall be no more negative than -3,500 cfs on a 14-day running average. Simultaneously, OMR flow shall be no more negative than -4,375 cfs on a 5-day average. Combined exports will go up between 300 and 400 cfs per day.

DFG has no further advice for the protection of longfin smelt.
