

## **WOMT Summary for June 12, 2012**

WOMT met and discussed the following:

The Smelt Working Group recommended no change in projected operations based on a review of delta smelt distribution and salvage data, current Delta conditions and projected operations. The Working Group also agreed that given their present distribution, existing constraining conditions was sufficient to protect longfin smelt. The Working Group will continue to monitor smelt salvage, larval smelt survey data, and delta hydrological conditions and will reconvene June 18, 2012, at 10 am.

Currently as of June 12, 2012, the FWS and DFG deem that no additional actions are needed for protection of delta and longfin smelt.

DOSS advice to WOMT and NMFS to continue to implement RPA Action IV.2.3 (OMR no more negative than -5,000 cfs, with the fish density triggers in place) until June 15 (Friday). DOSS will take a break through the summer and reconvene in October.

NMFS accepts the DOSS advice and determines that the DOSS advice is consistent with the intended implementation of Action IV.2.3 and sufficiently protective of listed species present in the Delta at this time.
