### April 29, 2014 Meeting

#### 1. General Information:

##### CVP

- *Keswick Release to upper Sacramento River @ 4450 cfs (increasing to 5000 cfs on Thursday due to anticipated in-stream demands)*
- *Nimbus Release to lower American River @ 800 cfs*
- *Goodwin Release to Stanislaus River @ 2500 cfs (increasing to 2900 cfs for 12-hour mini pulse, then decreasing to 2100 cfs tomorrow)*
- *Jones Pumping Plant @ 2500cfs (reducing to 2000 on Thursday due to expected decrease in Vernalis flows)*
- *X-channel Gates: Closed*
- *Federal Share of San Luis 567TAF*

##### SWP

- *Oroville Release to Feather River @ 800 cfs*
- *Clifton Court Allotment @500 cfs*
- *State Share of San Luis @386TAF*

##### Delta

- *Freeport Flow approx.6350cfs*

**FISH UPDATES:**

- **USFWS – Delta Smelt:** SWG met yesterday; at current and projected export levels, the risk of entrainment to delta smelt is low, therefore, no change in operations is recommended per SWG. No determination from USFWS necessary.
- **DFW – Longfin Smelt:** Export rates are protective of Longfin Smelt at this time; therefore, DFW has no recommendations for changes in operations.
- **NMFS – CV Salmonids, Steelhead, Sturgeon:** DOSS met this morning; updated Spring Run and Winter Run young-of-year distribution; No advice from DOSS; therefore, no NMFS determination necessary.

**SWRCB:**

- **Office of Delta Watermaster:** Based on current conditions in Delta, no Term 91 or 93 curtailment notices are being issued at this time; will continue to monitor conditions.
- **Office of Water Rights:** Board is holding a workshop on May 6 regarding the TUC Order modifications and extensions.

**Current Water Project Operations Status:** Project exports are being scheduled to meet the flow at Vernalis per the 3-day averaging period.
