October 21, 2014 Meeting

1. General Information:

CVP

- *Keswick Release to upper Sacramento River @ 5,000 cfs*
- *Nimbus Release to lower American River @ 1050 cfs*
- *Goodwin Release to Stanislaus River @ 700 cfs (Beginning October-November pulse flow on Stanislaus)*
- *Jones Pumping Plant @ 0 cfs today. 1 Unit (800 cfs) is being cycled – 2 days on and 1 day off.*
- *X-channel Gates: Open*
- *Federal Share of San Luis 203 TAF*

SWP

- *Oroville Release to Feather River @ 1500 cfs*
- *Clifton Court Allotment @ 300 cfs*
- *State Share of San Luis @ 206 TAF*

Delta

- *Freeport Flow approx. 5800 cfs*
- *Vernalis Flow approx. 400 cfs*
- *Delta Outflow approx. 4100 cfs*

FISH UPDATES:

- **DOSS – CV Salmonids and Sturgeon:** No recommendations, DOSS is monitoring triggers for Delta Cross Channel gate closure, none tripped since October 1. **NMFS** – nothing to add.
- **SWG – Delta Smelt:** SWG has not met so far this water year. **USFWS** – is monitoring data; nothing to add
- **DFW – Longfin Smelt:** Nothing To Report

SWRCB Activities:

- **Delta Water Master** – Craig Wilson’s replacement not picked yet.
- **Division of Water Rights** – Nothing To Report

Water Project Operations Controlling Factors: West Delta Water Quality, Delta Outflow requirements and Rio Vista flow requirements are all being monitored for compliance. Currently, west Delta salinity has increased above concern levels and the projects are curtailing Delta diversions to increase Delta outflow and repel west Delta salinity intrusion.
