### March 10, 2015 Meeting

#### 1. General Information:

##### CVP

- *Keswick Release to upper Sacramento River @ 3250 cfs*
- *Nimbus Release to lower American River @ 800 cfs*
- *Goodwin Release to Stanislaus River @ 250 cfs*
- *Jones Pumping Plant @ 2800 cfs*
- *Delta Cross-Channel Gates: Closed.*
- *Federal Share of San Luis 375 TAF*

##### SWP

- *Oroville Release to Feather River @ 800 cfs*
- *Clifton Court Allotment @ 1400 cfs*
- *State Share of San Luis @ 982 TAF*

##### Delta

- *Freeport Flow approx. 8,500 cfs*
- *Vernalis Flow approx. 600 cfs*
- *Delta Outflow approx. 4,100 cfs*
- *E/I Ratio (14 day average) approx. 35%*

### **OMR (cfs):**

- INDEX (as of 3/7/2015):  
5 day average: -4310 cfs,  
14 day average: - 4300 cfs
- USGS (as of 3/7/2015):  
5-day: -4030 cfs  
14-day: -4140 cfs

### **FISHERY UPDATES:**

- **DOSS** – Met today; no advice. Fish monitoring indicates a “baseline trickle” of salmonids are migrating through the Delta. There is a bit more catch in the beach seines. Group updated estimates of current fish distribution (see DOSS notes for detail)
- **SWG** – Met today – group evaluated OMR matrix for adults same as last week:  
  
Range between -1250 and -2000 = Low Risk of Entrainment  
Range between -2000 and -3500 = Low Risk of Entrainment  
Range between -3500 and -5000 = Medium Risk of Entrainment
- **NMFS** – No determination needed
- **USFWS** – No determination at this time
- **DFW** – No advice.

**SWRCB:**

- **Division of Water Rights** – SWRCB is holding a public workshop tomorrow (Feb. 18) on Drought Contingency Plan and Order on Temporary Urgency Change Petition.
- **Office of Delta Watermaster** - Notice of probable curtailments have been sent out to the holders of all water rights permits that contain Term 91 restrictions.
