

The Glenn County Planning and Public Works Agency is in receipt of the Draft 2007 Urban Water Management Plan for the Chico-Hamilton District. Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the draft plan.

The primary comment is the lack of information in the plan relating to Hamilton City District.

1. On Page 11, fourth paragraph, the Southern Pacific Railroad runs through Chico only, parallel to State Route 99.
2. Last paragraph on the same page should note that the Sacramento River is located about one mile east of Hamilton City.
3. Figure 2.1-3 does not show Hamilton City. The figure should show Hamilton City's location as a reference for the plan.
4. On Page 15, there is discussion of adoption of a greenline; this applies to Chico only and using the term "city" makes it unclear.
5. On Page 21, there is a discussion of a decline in groundwater levels of approximately 8 feet by 2012 in the Chico Urban Area. Is there similar information for Hamilton City?
6. On Page 22, there is discussion regarding wastewater treatment by the City of Chico, however, there is no similar discussion regarding wastewater collection and treatment by the Hamilton City Community Services District. The same can also be said for the discussion in Section 3.5.3.
7. Section 3.8 discusses chemicals of concern in the Chico District. Have similar concerns or no concerns been experienced in Hamilton City District?
8. The Water Conservation Best Management Practices is very interesting. Though, BMP #6 does not have a positive Net Present Value for the water agency and society, a combined incentive program to include low flow shower heads, low-flow toilets with the front-loading washers could have a positive value.
