I must assume you are referring to the UWMP for Cal Water's East Los Angeles District, since I have had no part in preparing a plan for the City of Montebello.

Thank you for pointing out the error associated with Figure 3.5-2., which is referenced on page 27. As it turns out the figure appears on page 29 and but is incorrectly labeled Figure 3.7-1. We will correct the label and for clarity move it forward one page.

With regard to current stage in the Water Supply Shortage Plan, I would have to say that we are not in any stage at the moment. It is my understanding that Metropolitan Water District and Central Basin have not as of today called for a specific reduction level (either voluntary or mandatory). I am in the process of verifying this with Central Basin MWD staff, and if I learn otherwise will advise you.
