

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-07

**RESOLUTION OF THE CHINO BASIN DESALTER AUTHORITY
ADOPTING THE
2005 CDA URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN (UWMP),**

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797, (Water Code Section 10610 et seq., known as the Urban Water Management Planning Act) during the 1983-1984 Regular Session, and as amended subsequently, which mandates that every supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually, prepare an Urban Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Chino Basin Desalter Authority* is a wholesale supplier of recovered groundwater in the western portion of Riverside and San Bernardino County; and


WHEREAS, the Urban Water Management Plan shall be periodically reviewed at least once every five years, and the Agency shall make any amendments or changes to its plan which are indicated by the review.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Chino Basin Desalter Authority* does hereby FIND, DETERMINE, DECLARE, AND RESOLVE as follows:

1. The 2005 CDA Urban Water Management Plan is hereby adopted.
2. The CDA is hereby authorized and directed to implement the Water Programs as detailed in the adopted 2005 CDA Urban Water Management Plan, including recommendations to the Board of Directors regarding necessary procedures, rules, and regulations in an effort to carry out effective and equitable water programs.
2. The Board Secretary is hereby authorized to file three hard copies and one electronic copy of the 2005 CDA Urban Water Management Plan with the State Department of Water Resources within 30 days following its adoption.
3. The Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
