Below are my comments on the draft 2005 UWMP. I have listed the **section** of the water code, the *information required* which I cannot locate and my explanation as to what DWR requires.

10631(a) ... Describe the service area of the supplier, including ... and **other demographic factors affecting the supplier's water management planning.** Plan does not provide demographic information as is indicated in Section 1.3.2 on page 1-5. I can glean it from other areas of the plan but the title of the section indicates the demographic information is included in that section.

10631(e) (1) Quantify, to the extent records are available, past and current water use, over the same five-year increments described in subdivision (a), and projected water use, **identifying the uses among water use sectors including, but not necessarily limited to, all of the following uses:**

- (A) Single-family residential.
- (B) Multifamily.
- (C) Commercial.
- (D) Industrial.
- (E) Institutional and governmental.
- (F) Landscape.
- (G) Sales to other agencies.
- (H) Saline water intrusion barriers, groundwater recharge, or conjunctive use, or any combination thereof.

(2) The water use projections shall be in the same five-year increments described in subdivision (a). The law requires quantification of water use by the above sectors. If this is not available for past and current, the data can be provided in the sectors you've identified in the plan (agricultural, urban and environmental). However, the future projections must be provided in the sectors defined by the law.

10632(d) Additional, mandatory prohibitions against specific water use practices during water shortages, including, but not limited to, prohibiting the use of potable water for street cleaning. Section 7.4.1 does not identify any mandatory prohibitions and the only one I was able to locate in the plan is the irrigation reductions. Information in Appendix I does not list prohibitions.

10632(f) Penalties or charges for excessive use, where applicable Section 7.4.2 does not list any penalties and I was not able to find any elsewhere.

10632(g) *An analysis of the impacts of each of the actions and conditions described in subdivisions (a) to (f), inclusive, on the revenues and expenditures of the urban water supplier* Section 7.5 does not address the impacts on either revenue or expenditures.

10632(h) *A draft water shortage contingency resolution or ordinance.* Appendix I does not include the Drought Contingency Plan, it merely mentions it and indicates it is located in the District Board and Policy Manual. Suggest you copy the plan from that manual and include it in Appendix I.

10633 Considerably more description and quantification regarding wastewater and recycled water is required by the law. Please see Water Code Section 10633 and review tables 33-39 for guidance.

Demand Management Measures

Please refer to DMM sheet in the review file. DWR requires an accounting of activities for in each DMM. If data is not available, please provide a reason as to why not. For those DMMs not implemented by NID (my reading of the plan indicates these are DMMs 2, 6, 10, and 14), a benefit/cost ratio needs to be provided.

GENERAL COMMENTS

The titles for Sections 1.3.2, 7.4.1, 7.4.2, do not accurately identify the information provided in the section.

Why does Section 7.5 include information that is not relevant to NID? (This is the second paragraph, starting on top of page 7-8 with "Some water supply agencies establishas the water shortage stages increase.")
