

**RESOLUTION NO. 9752 (2005 Series)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO  
ADOPTING THE REVISED URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797 during the 1983-1984 Regular Session, and as amended subsequently, which mandates that every supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre feet of water annually, prepare an Urban Water Management Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is an urban supplier of water providing water to a population over 40,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan shall be periodically reviewed at least once every five years, and that the City shall make any amendments or changes to its plan which are indicated by the review; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan must be adopted, after public review and hearing, and filed with the California Department of Water Resources within thirty days of adoption; and

**WHEREAS**, The City has therefore prepared for public review a draft Urban Water Management Plan, and a properly noticed public hearing regarding the Plan was held by the City Council on December 6, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis Obispo did prepare and shall file said Plan with the California Department of Water Resources.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of San Luis Obispo that the Urban Water Management Plan, consisting of text with tables and figures, with changes reflected in the staff report presented to the Council on December 6, 2005, on file in the City Clerk's Office, is hereby adopted.


