At this time, the Act requires every urban water supplier serving water directly to customers to prepare and adopt an urban water management plan. This plan shall include the following provisions: (a) The management of urban water demands and efficient use shall be actively pursued to protect both the people of the state and their water resources, (b) The management of urban water demands and efficient use of urban water supplies shall be a guiding criterion in public decisions, and (c) Urban water suppliers shall be required to develop water management plans to actively pursue the efficient use of available supplies.
