

RESOLUTION NO. 12R-25

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF CHINO HILLS ADOPTING THE 2010 URBAN WATER
MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797 (Water Code Section 10610 et seq., known as the Urban Water Management Planning Act) during the 1983-1984 Regular Session, and as amended subsequently, which mandates that every supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre feet of water annually, prepare an Urban Water Management Plan, the primary objective of which is to plan for the conservation and efficient use of water; and

WHEREAS the City is an urban supplier of water providing water to a customer base in excess of 3,000; and

WHEREAS the Plan shall be reviewed at least once every five years, and that the City shall make any amendments or changes to its plan which are indicated by the review; and

WHEREAS the City has therefore prepared and circulated for public review a draft Urban Water Management Plan, and a properly noticed public hearing regarding said Plan was held by the City Council on June 12, 2012; and

WHEREAS the City did prepare and shall file said Plan with the California Department of Water Resources by June 21, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHINO HILLS DOES RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council does hereby adopt the 2010 Urban Water Management Plan.

SECTION 2. The 2010 Urban Water Management Plan will be filed with the California Department of Water Resources by June 21, 2012.


SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to implement the Water Conservation Programs as set forth in the 2010 Urban Water Management Plan, which includes water shortage contingency analysis and recommendations to the City Council regarding necessary procedures, rules, and regulations to carry out effective and equitable water conservation and water recycling programs.

SECTION 4. In the event of a water shortage, the City Council shall declare a Water Shortage Emergency according to the Water Shortage Stages and Triggers indicated in the Plan, and implement necessary elements of the Plan.

SECTION 5. The City Manager shall recommend to the City Council, as necessary, additional regulations to carry out effective and equitable allocation of water resources; and

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall certify as to the adoption of this resolution.


