The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has reviewed the City of Clovis' 2010 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) received on December 22, 2011. The California Water Code (CWC) directs DWR to report to the legislature once every five years on the status of submitted plans. In meeting this legislative reporting requirement, DWR reviews all submitted plans.

DWR's review of the City of Clovis' 2010 plan has found that the plan has addressed the requirements of the CWC. DWR's review of plans is limited to assessing whether suppliers have addressed the required legislative elements. In its review, DWR does not evaluate or analyze the supplier's UWMP data, projections, or water management strategies. This letter simply acknowledges that Clovis's UWMP has addressed these requirements. The results of the review will also be provided to DWR's Financial Assistance Branch.

DWR, in reviewing Clovis's UWMP, compared Clovis's AB1420 compliance forms with the city's UWMP demand management section. To hold true to the AB1420 implementation and coverage requirements, DWR recommends that the city complete the American Works Association (AWWA) Standard Water Audit and Balance using the AWWA water software within a year. Please refer to the California Urban Water Conservation Council coverage requirement for BMP 1.2 Water Loss Control.
