In compliance with the Urban Water Management Planning Act (Act), Dublin San Ramon Services District (DSRSD) is preparing its 2010 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP). This planning effort is being conducted to ensure that adequate water supplies are available to meet existing and future water demands in DSRSD's service area. The UWMP is updated every five years.

The UWMP will provide an overview of DSRSD's water deliveries and uses, water supply sources, efficient water uses, and demand management measures. Additionally, the 2010 UWMP will incorporate DSRSD's plans for achieving the water conservation practices needed to achieve the goal of reducing potable water consumption by 20% by 2020 in accordance with the Water Conservation Bill of 2009.

The status of the 2010 UWMP will be posted on DSRSD's web site, www.dsrdsd.com. A draft 2010 UWMP is expected to be released for public review in early May 2011. A public hearing will be held to provide an opportunity to comment on the draft in May 2011. Adoption of the plan is expected in June 2011. Additional notices will be distributed.


