

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-059

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDDING TO AMEND THE URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES PURSUANT TO ASSEMBLY BILL 797, THE "URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLANNING ACT," AMENDING DIVISION 6, PART 2.6, OF THE CALIFORNIA WATER CODE

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797 (Water Code Section 10610 et seq., known as the Urban Water Management Planning Act) during the 1983-1984 Regular Session, and amended subsequently, which mandates that every supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually, prepare an Urban Water Management Plan, the primary objective of which is to plan for the conservation and efficient use of water, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Redding is an urban water supplier providing water to a population of approximately 90,000 people; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Redding has therefore prepared an Urban Water Management Plan which incorporates Best Management Practices identified in the City of Redding's Federal Water Management Plan and will submit its Plan to the California Department of Water Resources; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Redding, in accordance with State of California guidelines and current criteria, will re-evaluate and resubmit its plan at least once every five years as or as conditions warrant;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Urban Water Management Plan is adopted by the City of Redding.



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDDING TO AMEND THE FEDERAL WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION AND PURSUANT TO SECTION 210 OF THE RECLAMATION REFORM ACT OF 1982

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior, United States Bureau of Reclamation, requires that water purveyors, as a condition of long-term water-service contracts for Central Valley Project water prepare a Federal Water Management Plan, the primary objective of which is to plan for the conservation and efficient use of water, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Redding is a United States Bureau of Reclamation water contractor providing water to a population of approximately 90,000 people; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Redding has therefore prepared a Federal Water Management Plan which incorporates Best Management Practices and will submit its Plan to the United States Bureau of Reclamation; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Redding, in accordance with United States Bureau of Reclamation guidelines and current criteria, will re-evaluate and resubmit its plan at least once every five years or as conditions warrant;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Federal Water Management Plan with current Best Management Practices Implementation Measures is adopted by the City of Redding.
