Dear Mr. Diggs:

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has reviewed the San Bernardino Valley Regional Urban Water Management Plan (amended 12/12) which included the urban water management reporting for the City of Redlands. The amended plan was received on December 21, 2012. The California Water Code (CWC) directs DWR to report to the legislature once every five years on the status of submitted plans. In meeting this legislative reporting requirement, DWR reviews all submitted plans.

DWR's review of the 2010 Amended Regional UWMP has found that the plan has addressed the requirements of the CWC including the requirements for the City of Redlands. DWR's review of plans is limited to assessing whether suppliers have addressed the required legislative elements. In its review, DWR does not evaluate or analyze the supplier's UWMP data, projections, or water management strategies. This letter is simply meant to acknowledge that the 2010 Amended Regional UWMP has addressed these requirements. The results of the review will also be provided to DWR's Financial Assistance Branch.
