Re: City of Sacramento CUWCC BMP Reports Correction:
(1) BMP 4 to be included in Exemption Claim; (2) BMP Reports to reflect Exempt Status

Dear Mr. Brostrom and Mr. Brown:

Thank you for your kind assistance for a necessary correction to the City of Sacramento Department of Utilities Best Management Practice (BMP) Reports and BMP Exemption Claim Submittal. This letter summarizes our discussions in December, 2011 to resolve an inconsistency noted in the reports.

As discussed, the City of Sacramento Department of Utilities claimed an exemption for some of the BMPs as established by the California Urban Water Conservation Council (CUWCC) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Given budgetary constraints, the City does not have sufficient resources to satisfy coverage requirements and filed exemptions for some BMPs for lack of funding for 2011 and 2012 (filed in March, 2011). The City is performing many of the BMPs but not at the coverage level required in the MOU, and therefore, respectfully requested exemption claims for BMPs 1.30 and 1.40, and BMPs 3.11 through 3.40.

In December, 2011, you kindly updated Julie Friedman that BMP 4 should have been included in the exemption claim submittal and was possibly overlooked as it was marked as exempt for lack of funding in the City's AB 1420 submittal.

Following from discussions and correspondence with Julie Friedman on December 12 and 22, 2011, Mr. Brown kindly relayed that CUWCC is able to assist with:

1. Including BMP 4 in the exemption claim request as exempt for lack of funding in 2011 and 2012;
2. CUWCC Staff will revise the BMP Reports to show the following BMPs as "Exempt" (rather than "Not on track"): BMPs 1.3 and 1.4, BMPs 3.11 through 3.4 and BMP 4. An email request from Julie Friedman will be sent to Natalie Calkins, CUWCC.
