Dear Mr. Moorrees:

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has reviewed the San Antonio Water Company's (Company) 2010 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) received on July 22, 2011. The California Water Code (CWC) directs DWR to report to the legislature once every five years on the status of submitted plans. In meeting this legislative reporting requirement, DWR reviews all submitted plans.

DWR's review of the Company's 2010 plan has found that the plan has generally addressed the requirements of the CWC with the following recommendations. DWR recommends that when updating this Plan in 2015, the Company:

1. Include an estimate of the minimum water supply available during each of the next three water years based on the driest three-year historic sequence for the agency's water supply. (CWC 10632 (a) (2)).
2. Provide a description of actions to be undertaken by the urban water supplier to prepare for, and implement during, a catastrophic interruption of water supplies including, but not limited to, a regional power outage, an earthquake, or other disaster. (CWC 10632 (a)(3)).
3. Address each Demand Management Measure (DMM) listed in the Water Code by providing a description of the program currently being implemented, or, for any DMM not being implemented, provide either a cost/benefit analysis, or a plan of implementation. DMM J (wholesale agency programs) did not properly address this requirement. (CWC Section 10631 (f) (1) (J)).

DWR's review of plans is limited to assessing whether suppliers have addressed the required legislative elements. In its review, DWR does not evaluate or analyze the supplier's UWMP data, projections, or water management strategies. This letter is simply meant to acknowledge that the Company's 2010 UWMP has addressed these requirements. The results of the review will also be provided to DWR's Financial Assistance Branch.
