2010 Guidebook Content

- ❖ 2010 Guidebook sections arranged by subject
- ❖ Clearly states UWMP requirements
- ❖ Comprehensive to improve both UWMP preparation and review process, as well as overall communication

2010 Guidebook Content

- ❖ Links Urban Water Conservation Bill (SBx7-7) and UWMP
- ❖ There is a section on climate change, but it is not required to be included in the 2010 UWMPs

2010 Guidebook Content


What the draft Guidebook will NOT include . . .

- ❖ Electronic data system details. Only general information is included.
- ❖ Target Method 4. It will be released in January 2011.




2010 UWMP Requirements


- ❖ Most basic 'requirements' are the same as in 2005, except for . . .
 - ◆ Including baseline and target data for Water Conservation Bill of 2009 compliance
 - ◆ Additional public notification
 - ◆ Changes associated with AB 1420
 - ◆ Consider indirect potable reuse options for recycled water use



Methodologies and the Guidebook

- ❖ Technical methodologies and Target Methods are to be used to develop base daily per capita water use, urban water use target, and interim urban water use target
- ❖ Technical methodologies and Target Methods were released as a separate document on October 1, but are an integral part of 2010 UWMPs

Methodologies and the Guidebook

❖ There are four steps to developing baselines and targets.

1. STEP 1: Determine base daily per capita water use
2. STEP 2: Determine urban water use target
3. STEP 3: Confirm urban water use target
4. STEP 4: Determine interim urban water use target

Developing Baselines and Targets







2005 Submittals by Month




Tentative Guidebook/Workshop Schedule

- ❖ Dec 2010: Draft Guidebook released; includes methodologies and Target Methods 1 to 3
- ❖ Early Jan 2011: Guidebook Workshop (and webinar)
- ❖ Late Jan or early Feb 2011: Final Guidebook released; adds Target Method 4 and electronic submittal
- ❖ Feb 2011: Statewide workshops



ONLINE UWMP SUBMITTAL




UWMP Online Submittal

- ❖ Will enable online submittal of UWMP-required data
 - ◆ Will enable water suppliers to download entered data into Excel format for inclusion in the UWMP
 - ◆ Will maintain information to support future UWMP submittals
 - ◆ Facilitates and prioritizes DWR review
 - ◆ Supports development of a DWR data base of statewide water system information

UWMP Online Submittal

- ❖ Is referred to as DOST (DWR Online Submittal Tool)
- ❖ Will be accessed on the DWR website
- ❖ Is being developed in conjunction with the PWSS online submittal application
- ❖ Is the first step in a standardized reporting tool
- ❖ Is planned to be available for the February workshops
