- ❖ In mid-January DWR will host a public workshop/webcast in Sacramento to take comments on the public draft


2010 Draft Guidebook Schedule

Water Conservation Implementation

- ❖ A description of the how a water supplier is planning on meeting the urban water use target is required.
 - ◆ Wholesalers: provide an assessment of their present and future measures, programs and policies to achieve water use reductions required in the Water Conservation Bill of 2009 (see 10608.36)

Water Conservation Implementation

- ❖ A description of the how a water supplier is planning on meeting the urban water use target is required.
 - ◆ Retailers: conduct at least one public hearing to allow community input regarding the implementation plan for complying with the Water Conservation Bill of 2009 (see 10608.26)

Non-Potable Water

- ❖ A number of questions in the last webinar on gross water calculations and whether non-potable water should be included.
 - Recycled water can be excluded
 - Non potable that is supplied for municipal or industrial purposes should be included



Low-Income Water Use Projections

- ❖ 2010 UWMPA requires that suppliers provide water use projections for low income single- and multi-family users
 - ◆ We understand that supplying specific quantities may be difficult
 - ◆ We are working on language to go into the guidebook

DMM/BMP Report Requirements

- ❖ CUWCC members can adopt plans with a placeholder for the 2009/2010 BMP reports and then submit the BMP report when it is available.
- ❖ The UWMPA requires description of DMMs be provided in the UWMP. AB 1420 compliance reports by themselves do not meet this requirement.
