Dear Mr. Emmert:

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has reviewed the City of Oxnard's 2010 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) received on June 13, 2011. The California Water Code (CWC) directs DWR to report to the legislature once every five years on the status of submitted plans. In meeting this legislative reporting requirement, DWR reviews all submitted plans.

DWR's review of the City of Oxnard's 2010 plan has found that the plan has addressed the requirements of the CWC. DWR's review of plans is limited to assessing whether suppliers have addressed the required legislative elements. In its review, DWR does not evaluate or analyze the supplier's UWMP data, projections, or water management strategies. This letter is simply meant to acknowledge that the City of Oxnard's 2010 UWMP has addressed these requirements. The results of the review will also be provided to DWR's Financial Assistance Branch.
