To Whom it May Concern:

Attached is a Grant Application for funding through the 2014 Water-Energy Grant Program for the London Water Conservation Project. A copy of our Board Resolution 2014-15 is included indicating our Board's authorization to submit this application and enter into an agreement with the State of California to accept funding for the proposed project.

Eligible Applicant Documentation: The London Community Services District is a local agency formed under California Government Code Section 61000 et seq. and as such has the legal authority to enter into grant agreements with the State of California.

Our District has applied for and received State and Federal funding for water and wastewater projects in the past. In the past few years our District has received and properly administered funding from both the State Department of Public Health and State Water Resources Control Board.

Urban Water Management Compliance: Due to our District small size (less than 500 connections), our District is not considered an Urban Water Supplier. Attached is a signed "Certification for Compliance with Metering Requirements for Funding Applications" indicating that our District is not an Urban Water Supplier. That said, the major purpose of submitting the attached application is to fund the installation of water meters.

Ground Water Management Compliance: The London Community Services District is located within the boundaries of the Alta Irrigation District (AID). The AID is the designated monitoring entity for the CASGEM program in the area that includes the London Community Services District. The Basin in which the AID and our District are situated is listed as a "High" priority basin.


Agricultural Water Management Compliance: No agricultural water suppliers will receive funding from this grant proposal if approved.

Surface Water Diversion Compliance: No surface water diverters will receive funding from this grant proposal if approved.

**CERTIFICATION FOR  
COMPLIANCE WITH WATER METERING REQUIREMENTS  
FOR FUNDING APPLICATIONS**

In 2004, Assembly Bill 2572 added section 529.5 to the Water Code, providing that, commencing January 1, 2010, urban water suppliers must meet certain volumetric pricing and water metering requirements in order to apply for permits for new or expanded water supply, or state financial assistance for the following types of projects:

1. wastewater treatment projects
2. water use efficiency projects (including water recycling projects)
3. drinking water treatment projects

For the purposes of compliance with Section 529.5, a "water use efficiency project" means an action or series of actions that ensure or enhance the efficient use of water or result in the conservation of water supplies.

**Please consult with your legal counsel and review sections 525 through 529.7 of the Water Code before completing this certification.**

Applicants Affected

This requirement applies to urban water suppliers.

*"Urban water supplier" means a supplier, either publicly or privately owned, providing water for municipal purposes either directly or indirectly to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually. An urban water supplier includes a supplier or contractor for water, regardless of the basis of right, which distributes or sells for ultimate resale to customers.*

When Certification is Required

State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB): The application for financial assistance must include a completed and signed certification form demonstrating compliance with the water metering requirements.

Department of Water Resources (DWR) funding applications: This certification must be completed and submitted with the funding application. Check the specific proposal solicitation package for directions on applicability and submittal instructions.

Department of Public Health (DPH) Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program: This certification must be completed and submitted with the executed Notice of Acceptance of Application (NOAA).
