

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SELF-HELP ENTERPRISES**

I.

The name of this Corporation shall be SELF-HELP ENTERPRISES.

II.

That the specific and primary purpose for which this Corporation is formed is to promote better living conditions for low-income families.

III.

The general purposes and powers for which this Corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To provide low-income families the opportunity to acquire new homes, to renovate or repair existing homes or to engage in other self-help projects.
2. To make and enter into contracts of every sort and kind permitted by law with an individual, firm, association and private, public or municipal corporation or body politic or department thereof, for the attainment of the exempt purposes of this Corporation.

IV.

This Corporation is organized pursuant to the general nonprofit corporation law of the State of California.

V.

This Corporation shall have no capital stock, but shall be supported by gifts, bequests, benefits and contributions made to the Corporation.

VI.

The property of this nonprofit corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

VII.

The principal place or office for the transactions of the business of the Corporation is located in Tulare County, California.

VIII.

The Board of Directors of this Corporation shall consist of the number set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation, provided, however, that the Board of Directors shall be not less than six (6) in number. 
