AUTHORIZATION AND ELIGIBILITY
REQUIREMENTS – “ELIGIBLE APPLICANT
DOCUMENTATION”**

Organized under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes and qualified to do business in California, University Enterprises, Inc. (UEI), is a nonprofit organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The specific purposes of UEI include assisting in and promoting the development, maintenance and operation of California State University, Sacramento (Sacramento State), as well as providing necessary and desirable equipment and facilities for its students and faculty.

UEI was formed as an auxiliary organization of the California State University and operates under an Operating Agreement with the Chancellor of the California State University, on behalf of the Board of Trustees, to, among other things, carry out activities relating to externally funded projects.

The Office of Water Programs (OWP) is a self-supporting unit of the Department of Civil Engineering in Sacramento State's College of Engineering and Computer Science. Much of OWP's operational funding is obtained through grants and contracts from sources external to Sacramento State, and this funding is administered by UEI pursuant to the above-referenced Operating Agreement. In order to effectuate the goals of the proposed project, UEI will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Sacramento State pursuant to which some project funds will be used to reimburse Sacramento State for its Facilities Management unit's costs associated with the project's consultants and subcontractor(s).

UEI has legal authority to enter into a grant agreement with the State of California.
