Armando, I can give you these estimates at this point.

1. Replace the small urinals with 0.125 urinals and new valves, cost would be \$811.26 each
2. Replace the larger urinals with 0.125 urinals and new valves, cost would be \$1045.00 each

At the C & D Building, we would have to alter the water piping for a new urinal.

This does not take into consideration ADA heights, etc. we would be using the existing rough-in locations. But looking at the cut sheets for the old urinals and the new urinals, they are very close to the same heights etc. I don't know if there will be any wall damage behind the urinals, would only find out once the urinals are removed.
