Hello,

[REDACTED] in San Bernardino County. They are a small district, solely on groundwater, a disadvantaged community, and with about 15,000 people. To increase conservation efforts they are interested in exploring Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) for their system. Is this something that could be funded through the Water Energy Grant program?

AMI would enable the District to more efficiently manage water distribution by remotely managing metering assets, and allow District customers the ability to detect leaks, view water usage, set alerts, and gather reports about their home water system in real time through the wireless sensor network. This project will help both the District and its customers reduce water and energy usage, which, in turn, will also reduce greenhouse gas emissions and help reduce water and energy costs.
