**PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION**

This proposal contains two projects. Project 1 would fund the conversion to water meters for those residents in the City of Merced that do not currently have a meter. All that remains to be metered is approximately 10,800 single family residents. The project would include the purchase and installation of meters. The meters will include cloud based software to allow satellite tracking and reading. Project 2 would upgrade existing meter data collection system to cloud based software, consistent with the new water meter conversion project (Project 1), project will reduce greenhouse gas emissions considerably by eliminating the need for a truck driving the route to read the meters.

Agreement Components	Attachments 3, 4, and 5	All necessary agreement component requirements were not met, as outlined in the PSP. The Work Plan tasks do not define the main activities, including magnitude or effort, necessary to complete the task. Work Plan tasks do not identify appropriate deliverables resulting from the activities described. Work Plan does not address CEQA compliance. The Schedule is not consistent with the tasks in the Work Plan.
