SUMMARY OF BUTTE CREEK INSTREAM FLOW REQUIREMENTS

The following summarizes the various instream flow requirements for the Butte Creek WMSA.

- 1.) Tracts 1 and 2 (M & T and Parrott) have dedicated 40.0 cfs of their water rights for instream flow purposes from either the PG&E import water or Butte Creek natural flow during the period of October 1 through June 30. This water is to be measured below Diversion #50.
- 2.) Tracts 25, 29, and 30 (Resource Renewal Institute) has dedicated their entire water right of 5.0 cfs from April 1 to October 15 and 1.5 cfs from October 16 to March 31 1st priority from Schedule 7 for instream flow purposes. This water is to be measured below Diversion #54. See amendment to Decree 18917 dated 5/11/98.
- 3.) Tract 4 (Decreed Owner E. E. White) and Tract 33 (Western Canal) changed their points of diversion from Diversions #62 and #63 to #61. See amendment to Decree 18917 dated 6/15/98. This amendment includes special stipulations by DFG regarding bypass (instream) flows for Tracts 4 and 33 as follows:
 - A.) 10 cfs from July 1 to October 1 from all water rights defined in Decree 18917 for Tracts 4 and 33 (Western/Ryan/McAlister). This water is to be measured below Gorrill Dam.
 - B.) 1.0 cfs for every 2.0 cfs water diverted under the multiplier water rights defined in paragraphs 84 and 87 until 80.0 cfs is available below Gorrill Dam. This water is to be measured below Gorrill Dam.
- 4.) Tracts 6 (Rancho Esquon) is required to bypass 60.0 cfs prior to the diversion of their SWRCB appropriative water right. See SWRCB License #11046 (= 66.0 cfs). This license was issued prior to items 1, 2, and 3 and is for the period of April 1 through June 15 only. The 60.0 cfs bypass flow is effectively superceded by item 3 (if item 3 water right diversions are being exercised) as this license is inferior to all water rights defined in Decree 18917.
