

### U.N. group publishes groundwater sustainability indicators

Water planners and managers recognize the importance of identifying and developing indicators. And the UN-World Water Assessment Programme (WWAP) has made it its cornerstone: "The significance of indicators in the overall context of assessment of water resources (are) the most 'vital instruments.'"
