Obama Administration releases federal Delta work plan

The Obama Administration on Tuesday released a work plan focusing on the water crisis in California, including the Delta. Six federal agencies have agreed on a list of actions to address the urgent need to provide reliable water supplies for 25 million Californians, while also protecting the Bay-Delta ecosystem upon which the supplies depend. Read more. Also, DWR Director Lester Snow responded to the announcement: "We are encouraged by the initiatives and progress outlined in this action plan for the Delta. It signals the strong commitment of federal agencies to resolve California's pressing water challenges and, more importantly, to work more closely with state agencies in dealing with the complex resources issues in the Delta." Water efficiency to be tested in NRCS 'high tunnel' pilot California's Imperial and Riverside counties are participating in a 3-year, 38-state U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service pilot project to determine if high tunnels, also known as hoop houses, are effective in improving water efficiency and providing conservation benefits to growers.
