Public listening sessions set for implementation of 2009 Water Conservation Act

The California Department of Water Resources has scheduled Public Listening Sessions regarding implementation of two projects as part of the 2009 Water Conservation Act or Senate Bill X7 7. The first will be in Sacramento on March 8, the second in Los Angeles on March 10. These first Listening Sessions will focus on the Urban Baseline Technical Methodologies and a Method for Calculating Urban Water Use Reduction Targets requirements of the Water Conservation Act of 2009.
