### **Water Plan's Vol. 3 Regional Reports, Vol. 4 Reference Guide nearly complete**

All but one Regional Report have been posted in [Volume 3](#) of the Water Plan Update 2009. Only the South Coast Regional Report remains to be posted. Volume 3 is a set of 12 regional reports. Also this week, more articles were posted on the Water Plan website in the [Volume 4 Reference Guide](#), which is nearly complete.

### **Moeller chosen project manager for Water Plan Update 2013**

Lewis Moeller has been named Project Manager for the California Water Plan Update 2013. ### **Kickoff for Water Plan Update 2013 will be held July 7**

A public workshop on Wednesday, July 7, will launch Update 2013 of the California Water Plan, outlining content features and outreach approaches. The agenda will include discussions on approach to forming and engaging advisory groups, along with potential strategies for both interest-based and regional outreach and engagement.
