Learning more about Update 2009

This past spring, DWR released Water Plan Update 2009. Today we'll bring you another tip on how best to get the most out of the Water Plan.

How to prepare for the future

Earlier issues of eNews focused on the three future scenarios presented in Update 2009, and how our regional and statewide water demands may vary dramatically by 2050. Each future scenario describes a different baseline for 2050, to which the water community would need to respond by implementing a mix of the 27 resource management strategies sum-

marized in the [Water Plan Highlights booklet](#). These strategies are the building blocks of integrated water management that provide California's regions a range of choices to diversify their water portfolios. Each strategy is described at length in [Volume 2 Resource Management Strategies](#) including recommendations to improve their implementation.
