### New tool will help water suppliers submit UWMP data

Water suppliers have a new tool for submitting data from urban water management plans (UWMPs). The [DWR Online Submittal Tool](#) (DOST) was made available this week. It will enable DWR to gather information on UWMPs throughout California and organize it in a statewide database. The DWR website also has an [online manual](#) with instructions for using DOST.

### Appropriations committee to look at proposed policy for levee vegetation management

The Federal Appropriations Committee of the California Water Commission will be meeting Monday, Aug. 8, in Sacramento. The [agenda](#) includes [challenges](#) DWR has found with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' proposed policy on vegetation management for levees. The committee will also discuss federal appropriations for California water and flood projects.

### Fifth staff draft of Delta Plan released, draft EIR to follow

The Delta Stewardship Council (DSC) has released the [fifth staff draft](#) of the Delta Plan along with [10 appendices](#) related to the plan. It is the final draft before this month's expected release of the draft environmental impact report (EIR). ### OPC looking for public feedback on draft plan for ocean protection

The [California Ocean Protection Council](#) (OPC) is asking for public feedback on its [draft strategic action plan](#) for ocean and coastal protection. The draft plan was developed to provide vision and direction for advancing ecosystem management and protection over the next five years.
