ISB teleconference will focus on final staff draft of the Delta Plan

The next meeting of the Delta Independent Science Board (ISB) will be a teleconference featuring the board finalizing its review of the Delta Plan's [final staff draft](#). Science advisory panel issues strategies for monitoring CECs in California's water

A report outlining four strategies for tracking chemicals in the state's water has been posted online. [Monitoring Strategies for Chemicals of Emerging Concern \(CECs\) in California's Aquatic Ecosystems](#) has been submitted to the State Water Resources Control Board.
