Governor takes wraps off plans for developing Delta water tunnels

This morning, Gov. Edmund G. Brown Jr. and Interior Secretary Ken Salazar announced details on the Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP). Sediment is next in line for a Water Plan RMS workshop

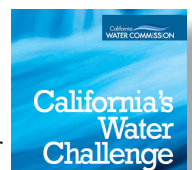
