Next Water Plan forum will focus on North Lahontan region

DWR to discuss integrated water management at floodplain conference

The latest strategies, tools and technologies to reduce flood risk will be part of this year's [Floodplain Management Conference](#) in Sacramento. It will be Sept. 4-7.
