Pollution prevention RMS workshop added to Water Plan calendar

A resource management strategy (RMS) [workshop](#) has been added to the *California Water Plan Update 2013* calendar. Details for the workshop on pollution prevention are being developed, but it will be Thursday, Oct. 25, in Sacramento. An RMS is a program or policy used to help manage water resources.
