IRWM workshop series gets under way next week in Clovis

Beginning next week, DWR will host the first of [five workshops](#) to help develop long-term goals for integrated regional water management (IRWM) in California. The initial workshop will be Wednesday, April 10, in Clovis. Others will be held in Temecula, Burbank, Red Bluff and Sacramento. The workshops will cover better alignment of state and federal programs, identification of funding, support of regional water management groups and other topics.
