

### Proposition 1 Water Bond funding outlined at tribal government consultation

Information on Proposition 1 Water Bond funding opportunities for tribal governments was discussed this week in Sacramento. The tribal consultation, on June 9 and 10, covered topics including groundwater sustainability, watershed management, and flood management.
