

South Coast region groundwater chapter posted, webinar on tap next week

The chapter on [South Coast Hydrologic Region](#) has been posted as part of [California's Groundwater Update 2013](#). The chapter will be discussed during a [webinar](#) on Monday, July 27. Two other recently posted chapters, [San Francisco Bay](#) and [Sacramento River](#) will also be covered during the webinar. The update is a compilation of groundwater information used to enhance [California Water Plan Update 2013](#).



Groundwater basin boundary regulations available online for public review

After being presented to the [California Water Commission](#), the draft [groundwater basin boundary emergency regulations](#) are available online. The regulations cover a process for local agencies requesting modifications to groundwater basin and subbasin boundaries. The [public comment period](#) will be open through Friday, Sept. 4.

DWR releases 2015 guidebook for agricultural water management plans

The [2015 agricultural water management plan \(AWMP\) guidebook](#) has been released by DWR. The guide provides details on new requirements, plus other information to help agricultural water suppliers prepare their AWMPs. Several workshops on the development of AWMPs are being planned. Once details are finalized they will be posted on the [DWR Web site](#).

Water commission sets three public hearings on Water Storage Investment Program

The California Water Commission will hold three public meetings to provide details on its [Water Storage Investment Program](#). The discussion will include the steps needed to develop the program. The first meeting will be July 27, in [Napa](#). The others will be July 30, in [Davis](#), and Aug. 10, in [Bakersfield](#).

Truckee, Watsonville, and Sacramento are next on the state funding fair schedule
