

\$231 million of integrated water management projects recommended for funding

Public comments are being accepted on the draft funding recommendations for more than \$231 million in [Proposition 84 Implementation Grant](#) solicitations. Of the [37 funding applications](#) received by DWR, 26 projects that support integrated water management have been recommended for funding. The comment deadline is Friday, Nov. 13.

Applications being accepted from counties with stressed basins

The [Sustainable Groundwater Planning Grant Program](#) has released the final guidelines and [proposal solicitation package](#) for counties with stressed basins. Eligible projects include those that improve sustainable management of groundwater, or groundwater plans that protect basins. The application deadline is Tuesday, Dec. 8.

SWRCB sets new date for groundwater sustainability workshop

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) has rescheduled one of its workshops on the Proposition 1 element of the [Groundwater Sustainability Program](#). The workshop originally set for Nov. 17, in [Los Angeles](#), will be held Nov. 20. Other workshops will be Nov. 16, in [Sacramento](#), and Nov. 18, in [Fresno](#).
