IWM Sector Roles

- Implementers

- Move policy and decisions to action

- Operators

- Build, maintain and run infrastructure

- Local Land Use Planners and Decision-Makers

- Plan and determine physical layout, character and disposition of landscapes/watersheds

- Regulators

- Set and enforce standards and statues pertaining to natural resources

● Land Use Planners and Decision-Makers


- Engage IWM planning processes
